Welcome back to Lodge. I hope you all had a wonderful summer. As we were dark in July, it was good seeing everyone at our August meeting.

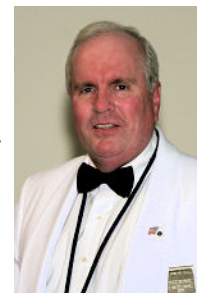
We are getting close to the fall season, and with cooler temperatures coming, we are planning to have a Lodge work party at the
